DETAILS:

Entries: Submit one poem only by March 15 to poems@artsofcarvercounty.org

- **STUDENT ENTRANTS:**
 - To be eligible, students must attend school in Carver County—public, private or home school.
 - The student's name, phone, grade level, school name, contact email, and poem title should be submitted in the body of the email only.
 - Attach the poem to the email as a Word document or PDF and indicate only the category of submission in the upper right-hand corner of the poem: k-2, 3-5, 6-8, or 9-12. *Do not include the student poet's name on the poem.*
- **ADULT ENTRANTS:**
 - Adults may enter as Carver County Residents or Non-Residents.
 - The adult's name, address, phone, contact email, poem title, and residency category (Resident, Non-Resident) must be submitted in the body of the email only.
 - Attach the poem as a Word document or PDF and indicate Resident or Non-resident only in the upper right-hand corner of the poem, no name or contact information.
